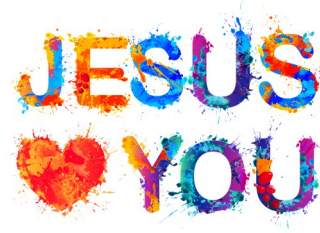

Principles and Camps



JESUS LOVE

At Cornerstone Church of Blaine we want children to be connected in a dynamic relationship with Jesus. Jesus loves them and we want children to know that love! The kids will grow through relationships and small group Bible lessons learning about who God is to them!



EXPRESSION

Each evening in **ART AND CRAFTS CAMP** the kids will use their skills of expression and creativity to make projects using a variety of techniques and media (paint, modeling clay, pastels, etc.). The kids will show off their creativity with a presentation on Sunday morning after camp.



TEAMWORK

Each evening in **ACTION GAMES CAMP** the kids will take part in team-based action games. All games will involve teamwork, action, and most importantly, FUN!!!
